- Ability to work in and contribute to an overall staff team.

- Demonstrates the ability to raise-up leaders and cast vision effectively.
- Commitment to making disciple-making disciples.
- Evidence of personal spiritual growth and a healthy lifestyle.
- Commitment to excellence and creativity.
- Model standards and expectations of leaders within Connection Church including:
 - Heart and Soul (member) at Connection Church and attending regularly
 - Tithing at least 10%
 - Participation in a Connect Group
 - Satisfactory completion of felony statement/background check

Responsibilities:

- Reports directly to the Lead Pastor
- Meet regularly with Lead Pastor for encouragement, support and sharing vision for this ministry area of the church.
- Follow all Vision/Values/Standards of Connection Church Rincon.
- Assist in creation of weekly standards/processes and systems for the ministry areas under this role.
- 1. CONNECTION STUDENTS: "Connecting Students to a growing relationship with Jesus."
 - Attend Staff Meetings
 - Responsible for the overall vision and direction of the Connection Students Ministry.
 - Lead Connection Student services



- Implement discipleship plan for students.
- Strategize and execute plan to reach unreached students in community.
- Communicate effectively with parents monthly about upcoming series and events.
- Commitment to making multiplying disciples of and investing in the student leaders.
- Recruit, train, and invest in and build a team of Connection Students Volunteers.
- Attend and/or coordinate leaders to attend sports games, recitals, and lunches to interact, get to know, and build relationships with students and their peers.
- Consistently improve the Connection Student Ministry, staying true to the aligning vision values and culture of Connection Church.
- Monitor Connection Students budget.
- Implement 2 trips:
 - Missional trip directed at discipling/ developing our students.
 - Fun trip directed at reaching new students and creating relationships with current ones.
- Replace yourself: Identify a leader and begin investing in that person to teach them how to do your role.

2. LEADERSHIP

- Commit to developing personal leadership skills and pastoral ministry weekly via books, podcasts, and discipleship meetings.
- Preach when assigned by Lead Pastor
- Participate in pastoral care as needed by congregation

3. SUNDAY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate with Guest Services to make sure everything is properly set up each week.
- Serve and assist in KK, Guest Services or wherever needed on Sundays.
- Motivate and encourage Connectors.
 - Help facilitate & set a culture of serving and hospitality for our Sunday services.
- Assist Lead Pastor in any teaching environments as needed.
